

# Level 3 Advanced Pedagogy

*Dive into deep instructor preparation in this semester-long series. Advanced Pedagogy is designed for postdocs and graduate students who are interested in pursuing teaching positions after completing their programs. Over the semester, you will prepare a teaching portfolio, including a teaching statement, an aligned lesson plan, student evaluations, and a diverse collection of workshops curated for your individual professional development goals.*

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## Course Design and Planning Engaging Lessons

This three-part session covers "Backward Design" and provides participants with experience in planning a lesson, and subsequently a course, by aligning classroom activities and assessments to high-level learning outcomes and discipline-specific core concepts and competencies.



## Improving Teaching Based on Student Feedback

Often, instructors use their end-of-semester evaluations to receive feedback from students and improve their teaching, yet, this is too late to affect your students and their learning needs.

This session provides resources for soliciting student feedback earlier and how to use that feedback to improve teaching and learning outcomes.



## Writing a Teaching Statement

One of the most important components of a teaching portfolio is the teaching statement or philosophy of teaching.

This reflective writing session and peer review provide opportunities to think about what you have gained as an educator and how to communicate these ideas to others.



## Student-Centered Course Artifacts

This session discusses the significance of decolonizing course materials like syllabi and course language. Participants explore various forms of syllabi and practice developing their own.



## Mapping Technology to Content and Managing Canvas

In this two-part session, our instructional designers explore how to navigate teaching technologies to meet instructional needs.

The second session goes into detail about how to organize and manage a course using Canvas, and the useful features therein.
